Poster Presenting 101

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Key Elements of poster design

- 1. Font Style & Size
 - Font: Times New Roman(Titles) and Arial(Body Text)
 - Font sizes: Title 100-85pt

Authors' names 60-50pt

Headings 36pt Primary text 24pt Minimum font = 18pt

- 2. Color Scheme
 - University or organization scheme
- 3. Graphics
 - When resizing make sure formatting and alignment are intact
- 4. Institution Template
- 5. Content Distribution
- 6. Readability
 - Be sure text is legible at a distance
 - Avoid clutter
 - Organize data in tables & charts
- 7. Proofreading
 - Ask multiple people

Key preparation for poster presentations

- 1. Elevator speech
 - Who you are
 - What you did
 - Why it matters
- 2. Professional Dress
 - Men: Slacks, dress shirt, tie, suit jacket (optional)
 - Women: Slacks/pencil skirt, dress shirt, dress
 - Shoes: professional, but comfortable (you will be standing)
- 3. Poster Copies & References
 - Have several of each printed
- 4. Business Cards
 - Free @ www.vistaprint.com
- 5. Key discussion points
 - If someone only has five minutes at your poster what do you tell them
 - What you did, how you did it, what you found, why it's important
- 6. Approachability
 - Look alive!
 - · Don't stand with arms crossed
 - Engage people that are walking past
 - "Are you familiar with ABC"
- 7. BRING THE POSTER!
